Dear readers,

The newest edition of the *Science and Society* scientific journal is, as always, addressing the current topics. This time, we are focusing on contemporary migration which is shaking up not only Europe, but the entire international community, thus changing demographic, cultural and security structure of the contemporary society.

In the thematic section named **“Migration crisis and contemporary society”**, you are presented with an opportunity to read valuable researches of very competent both domestic and foreign experts, which dealt with security, legislative and political aspects of the migration crisis. Prof. Zoran Kilibarda has explained in his work the contemporary trends of population movements and security challenges following the migration crisis, with a special emphasis on EU. The research of Swiss professor Markus Mohler is also dedicated to migrations. He explained triple legal problems of EU, predisposed by the migration crisis, at the same time elaborating in great detail all legal challenges which is EU currently facing, providing all significant conventions and documents of the EU. Prof. Predrag Pavličević provided us in his work with an analysis of political aspect of contemporary migrations, with a special emphasis on the problem of EU multiculturalism.

The second part of this issue is called **“Extremism and social networks”**, where Dimitris Panagiotakis analyzed in great detail contemporary right-wing extremism in Greece, taking the example of “Golden dawn”. He gave an explanation of the ideological basis of this party, as well as all potential threats, which are caused in Greece by the extreme right-wing.

As always, we have also given space in this issue for works written by our students. Jelena Vraneš, as a student of the “Terrorism, organized crime and defence” masters program at the University of Belgrade, has prepared a very useful research on the topic of misuse of social networks for terrorist purposes.

The last pages are reserved for presentation of newest scientific monographies. This time, full-time professor Dragan Simeunović has presented the newest book of professor assistant Marija Đorić “Extreme left-wing: ideological aspects of left-wing extremism”, which was recently published by the Institute for political studies.
