As always, we have again dedicated a special place in our magazine to the postgraduates of the University of Belgrade (department: Terrorism, Organized Crime and Security). **Jovan Šipovac** researched rivalry between SCO and ASEAN through a very professional review of their competition, and **Irena Đorđević** conducted a case study which is very current and worthy of the attention regarding the infiltration of ideology in media contents, which is being realized through representation of ISIS in the media in Serbia.

The last pages of our magazine are, as a rule, dedicated to reviews of the most current books. This time, it is a remarkable monograph written by professor Dragan Simeunović entitled "Serbian Statehood Thought", reviewed by Marija Đorić.
