MIGRANT CHAOS - ITS CLASSIFICATION AND POTENTIAL RE-SPONSES TO THE CHALLENGES OF MIGRANT WAVES, AS PART OF THE HYBRID AND ASYMMETRIC WARS OF THE PRESENT

Apstract:

The victory of transnational corporations over the USSR and M. Gorbachev's signing of the de-facto capitulation to the West created, in international relations, a Maltese order embodied in the absolute rule of a superpower over the rest of the planet. The arrogance of the hegemon destroyed what was left of international law and created an environment in which, on the basis of expressed financial interests, force could be applied with impunity to any member of the international club. In these circumstances, examples of the use of armed force, blackmail and reckless conditioning, called hybrid wars, wars under other people's flags or asymmetrical (armed and unarmed) conflicts in the new literature, appear in history. An indispensable part of them is the artificially induced mass-migration, carefully designed and targeted at hegemon's most dangerous political and economic competitors. Hiding behind carefully worded and publicly beautifully nurtured euphemisms about so called human rights, the rule of international law and the transparency of political activity, the makers of migrant chaos continue to pull the strings on the international scene, playing with tens of millions of human lives. Following the renunciation of national sovereignty, European countries are in a situation where they are unable to protect their borders, population and economy from the migrant tsunami. Their citizens, albeit loyal to their country, are put in the position of silent extras, from whom the globalist elites expect to accept whatever is served in the globalist play whose scenario is the destruction of nation-states. This paper is an attempt by two authors to classify different types of migration, in order to facilitate the understanding of the matter and to create the basis for further scientific research in this field.

Key words: *migration, chaos, migrant flows, classification, globalization, hybrid war, asymmetric war, financial terrorism, financial colonialism.*

INTRODUCTION

Migration has always represented not only a simple mechanical relocation of people from one territory to another, but also a complex social process, linked to numerous economic and sociological problems and challenges. Whether we use the scientific hypothesis that about 1.5 million years ago, people from Africa migrated across the globe, or the fact that through Mochanov's research¹ human resources found in Siberia, about 2.2 million years old, recognize that migration has played a key role in the history of our species' survival on the planet. From its creation somewhere in prehistory to the 21st century migration has always been represented in the demographic picture of human society, as well as birth and mortality, after all. At the outset, it is assumed that it had a limited character, as it was more difficult for people to make long journeys, but there are also historical facts that indicate that there were groups of people whose ambitions were not confined to certain narrow living localities. Although in recent years we have interpreted them from our perspective in the form of indisputable endangerment, no one can deny that migration has played a huge role in the development of humanity. We are not talking about the process of conquering a territory, but the fact that the migration of the population is connected with the development of productive forces, education, the development of the largest number of languages known today, and of course, the mixing of peoples, which in itself has brought new ideas, experiences and new quality.

It is not to mention that feudal wars, however bloody, did not, as a rule, result in major migration. An interesting example, whose contexts and consequences can still be seen today, is the conquest of the Iberian Peninsula by the caliph Omajadi al-Walid in the eighth century, realized with the help of Arabs and Berbers, who in Valencia were called Saracens. Following the military victory at Tariq, in the Gabal Tariq area (Gibraltar) on April 28, 711, al-Walid of Damascus, his capital, promised the Catholic nobility of Seville and Cordoba the retention of their

position and a very gallant attitude towards converts, thereby establishing centuries-old Islamic domination in the new state of Al-Andalus, lasting for the next eight centuries, that is until 1492. The education of Islamic society created two groups: a predominantly Muslim group comprising Berbers, Arabs, and mullahs (mullahs - Christians and Jews, mainly Sephardic, who converted to Islam), and a subordinate made up of Christians, Jews (Sephardic, Romani, etc.), slaves and prisoners of war. Each of the groups had three classes, the high, called "hash", the middle class of the reputable "a jan" and the low class, "ama". Today's Maghreb Islamists often refer to the existence of al-Andalusia, dreaming that by increasing new migrant waves and settling not only Spain but the entire Iberian Peninsula, they would reestablish a dominant Islamic majority in this part of the world and regain power over Christians.

CONCEPTUALLY, WHAT IS CHAOS?

According to ancient Greek mythology, chaos is supposedly the original state of the Universe, it is an element, a terrible desolation, a state of no form, order, or a completely indeterminate state of things, but what is perhaps the most important to determine its sign and substance, is the state made of accident. The philosophy and mythology of ancient antiquity considered chaos a completely unordered basis of the World. Together with Earth, Tartar (the abyss of total non-existence from which there is no return) and Eros, Hesiod regarded chaos as one of the beginning², who unmarriedly gives birth to a married couple, Ereb (Male Correlate of the Night) and Night. Being a pure renunciation itself, it naturally creates negative forces, Darkness and Night. It appears first, but it certainly is not the creative beginning of the Cosmos, nor the embryo of matter for the Universe, it merely provides a space, a kind of stage for the development of positive forces, Gea-Earth and Eros-Love, who are not born of him, but in parallel with him and after him. Parallel to the first interpretation of the term, there emerges an etymological interpretation of chaos, not from the term χάος - desolation, doom, abyss, derived from the verb χαίνω - yawn, to be wide open, which is related to the beginning of the formation of Universe, but from the term γέειν - liti (in Zeno the Stoic, etc.), which, in accordance with the new Greek etymology, is most commonly identified with

water. Unlike the first notion of chaos, which is desolate and more decorative, the second notion is not alone, because under the action of the whirlwind it creates a universe, so it is not barren. Ferekid and Ausilaus considered chaos in the up-to-date philosophy as the beginning of every being, with the first of them, chaos with water, celebrated as primacy. For Euripides, chaos was the space between earth and sky, and for Aristophanes, chaos coexisted with Tartar, Night, and Erebus, and appeared in the form of a living mythological being, which in its conjunction with Eros gives birth to a bird, the foundation of all living things. For Marcus Aurelius, chaos was first and foremost an abyss of time, on both sides endless eternity, a hunger without borders that absorbs all that exists.

MIGRATIONS - THEIR CLASSIFICATION, MIGRANT WAVES AND THEIR DEVASTATING RESULTS

Considering the aspects of migration and the migrant crisis, we must inevitably begin by defining the notion of a modern state as: a) a legal entity with a permanent population, b) precisely defined state borders and c) a government capable of exercising sovereignty. All three factors are necessary for one entity to be called a state. Mirgants are citizens of a particular country, they move across the territory of one or more states and settle in a place acceptable to them in another country. The refusal to live in the social conditions of their home country and the tendency to move, most often to meet certain needs or to avoid adverse events for themselves, to a country with a different political and economic condition, which is willing to receive them (and in some cases not), is the essence of mass migration at the beginning of the 21st century. These terms organically complement the concepts of citizenship, aliens and stateless persons or apolitical persons. The status of a national of a country is an important determinant on the basis of which our particular obligations and rights derive. In each country aliens, as well as stateless persons, are denied a certain level of rights and obligations. Until recently, almighty anarcho-liberal capitalism (aka ALC) has since 1968 sought, as far as possible, to equalize the two categories of people mentioned in one state, without taking too much into account citizenship. We are witnesses that such fairy-tale presentations of reality never come to life, although certain groups have been enormously enriched on them. Without challenging the place of human freedoms in modern society, all states facing mass and uncontrolled migration have come to the same conclusion independently - that freedom (personal and general) can only

be achieved if all civic obligations are fulfilled. From employment, paying taxes, to fitting into the prescribed social framework at the local and federal level, in the recipient country. Otherwise, a migrant recipient country builds a system in which migrants without substantive rights have more rights than the native population especially if such (anti) systems are imposed externally and by coercion, a serious disruption of the political system is born, as well as xenophobia and segregation of citizens from migrants of all kinds (legal, illegal, economic or political), whose escalation can seriously undermine the security and sovereignty of the state. In this way, a destabilized state is also a problem for its neighbors, who can realistically expect instability to spill over borders very quickly, especially if we have modern means of communication.

Classification of Migration

Using the mindset and scientific approach of Karl von Line,³ based on the data collected on completed and recent migrations, a basic classification can be made by different types of this sociological and political process. Viewed from the perspective of nation-states and the institutions that represent them, migration can be systematized in many ways. Basically, this can be done according to the following basic criteria: 1) the number of persons migrating, 2) the length of time of migration, 3) in relation to existing national borders, 4) in relation to the geographical origin of the migrants, 5) in relation to gender migrants, 6) in relation to the level of education of the migrant population, 7) in relation to the age of the migrants, 8) in relation to the will of the migrant country, 10) based on the basic economic characteristics of the migrants, 11) on the basis of mobility and 12) on the basis of three basic contemporary poly tic global mega-trend.

- 3.1.1. Migrations by the number of participants can be divided into:
 - 3.1.1.1. individual,
 - 3.1.1.2. group
 - 3.1.1.3. mass.

All these categories may, in certain circumstances, be the subject of interest of the intelligence, security, police or judicial authorities of a country. Individual migration, the subjects of which are prominent members of international terrorist groups, paramilitary or paramilitary organizations, private military companies or participants in war crimes, crimes against humanity, international peace and security, and even to certain categories of highly specialized experts, such as experts on weapons of mass destruction (nuclear, biological and chemical) or IT warfare experts, experts in modern aircraft, nuclear power plants, digitized transport, pilots and the like, will always be under the watchful eye of all members of the international scene.

- 3.1.2. With respect to the time duration of the migration process, they can be divided into:
 - 3.1.2.1. short-lived, which may be:
 - 3.1.2.1.1. daily
 - 3.1.2.1.2. weekly and
 - 3.1.2.1.3. seasonal
 - 3.1.2.2. long lasting, generally longer than 5 years and
 - 3.1.2.3. permanent, when human beings settle in new territory for a longer period of time.
- 3.1.3. Migrations can also be classified on the basis of state border criteria, and that:
 - 3.1.3.1. within one state,
 - 3.1.3.1.1. from village to town,
 - 3.1.3.1.2. from town to village (a fresh example of Poland, which, with an adequate strategy and financial support, managed to permanently dislocate a significant population from urban parts of the country to rural parts of the country)
 - 3.1.3.1.3. from an underdeveloped to a developed region.

- 3.1.3.2. migration across one state border. There have been many such migrations in history. Perhaps the most famous of this type is the mythical exile of Jews, about 600,000 of them, from Ancient Egypt to the Sinai Desert. We all know that in the 13th century BCE, by religious tradition, Jews were led into the desert by the prophet Moses⁴ (son of Pharaoh Ehnaton and the local beauty of Kiya) and his father-in-law, the priest Iophore. In addition to their very modest personal possessions, they also brought with them the Arc of the Covenant.⁵ The exile into the desert reportedly lasted 40 years.
- 3.1.3.3. migration across multiple national borders. Hungarian Prime Minister Viktor Orban accuses billionaire George Soros of massive and uncontrolled influx of refugees from the Middle East and Africa into Europe across multiple borders,⁶ behind the activities of the globally present Open Society Fund.⁷ It is evident that Soros is behind the activities of certain organizations related to the so-called migrant flows, which have fostered the illusion of welcome in the Westerner Europe in millions of migrants, creating in their minds a personal cognitive chaos that multiplied at the migrant collective level, creating a certain mental space for various forms of manipulation and abuse. It seems that the makers of migrant chaos in Europe have previously reckoned with the unmanageability of such macroprocesses performed on other people's terrain.

- 3.1.4. In relation to the geographical (continental) origin of migrants, migration can be classified as:
 - 3.1.4.1, within one continent
 - 3.1.4.2. transcontinental migrations.
- 3.1.5. In relation to the sex of the migrants:
 - 3.1.5.1. males,
 - 3.1.5.2. females,
 - 3.1.5.3. both sexes.
- 3.1.6. in relation to the level of education of the migrants:
 - 3.1.6.1. persons of no or low education,
 - 3.1.6.2. persons of average education,
 - 3.1.6.3. persons with higher education, completed academic studies, specializations, masters and doctoral levels of education and more, which is often referred to in everyday terminology as "brain drain". The IOM views this brain drain in the form of a "situation in which a state loses the most educated and most skilled individuals in the most productive age, at a speed that is (supposedly an author's note *) impossible to make up for by the influx of new staff needed to develop the country." It should be noted that for IOM, human capital "encompasses the knowledge and skills acquired in pre-school, primary and secondary school, college, specialist or various postgraduate studies, various forms of non-formal education and work experience. The education and talent of a specialist of a particular profession is measured by millions of any monetary unit, and there are those whose material value simply cannot be expressed.

- 3.1.7. Migrations can also be classified according to the age of the migrants:
 - 3.1.7.1. migrations of minors,
 - 3.1.7.2. migrations of adults:
 - 3.1.7.2.1. adults capable of working
 - 3.1.7.2.2. adults incapable of working, advanced in age and sick.

3.1.8. In relation to the will of the migrants:

3.1.8.1. voluntary migration, the formation of which involves so-called pushpulls, meaning the repulsive and attractive factors, which are inherently abstract and largely used to formally explain migration. Such migration is often analyzed in terms of a political science hypothesis, but according to many researchers the spatial mobility of the population does not lead to a universal principle of migration functioning. With each subject, the "model of repulsion and attraction" is different, 11 so it is almost impossible to define common factors of population displacement, whether international or intra-country migration. That there were also people who immediately saw what the background of mass migration was, is the fate of former chairman of the board of directors of Deutsche Bank, Tila Sarazin. He publicly criticized the project of preparing and realizing the violent repopulation of German and the societies of major European countries, France, Belgium, the Netherlands and others, their destruction inside, by Haranger, which he presented in his book "German Destruction", sold only in the SRN in a fantastic circulation of over 1.1 million copies. 12 Due to concerns about the future of Germany and a publicly expressed political stance, he was urgently left without a very well-paid job at Deutsche Bank.!

3.1.8.2. forced migrations:

- 3.1.8.2.1. migration triggered by natural disasters, earthquakes, large-scale fires, floods, volcanic eruptions and the like;
- 3.1.8.2.2. migration triggered by human activities such as war, economic crises, expulsion from a specific territory on different grounds, and more. Depending on the type of subjective cause of migration, it is possible to divide it into:

3.1.8.2.2.1. state activity:

- 3.1.8.2.2.1.1. within state borders,
- 3.1.8.2.2.1.2. pressure on a certain population to emigrate beyond national borders. Among the most recent examples is the statement of Burhan Kuzu, former advisor to the President of the Republic of Turkey, Recep Tayyip Erdogan, to the Blumberg news agency. At the height of the migrant crisis, he took advantage of the situation in Turkey and threatened the European Union through the media: "If the door opens, Europe will be strengthened." Recall that in 2015 more than 7,000 migrants were arriving daily to the Greek islands in search for a better life.
- 3.1.8.2.2.2. activities of transnational companies and international financial organizations. This is how transnational corporations and organizations and their instruments of power operate, whether they are state resources or so-called. Private military companies (hereinafter PVC), Colonels of the People's Liberation Army (NOARK) Kiao Ling and Wang Hiangsi have called "projected forced migration", which is planned and carried out in a "war without borders". They attribute the application of this method of warfare not only to Osama bin Laden, but to other exponents of Western globalist politics such as George Soros. ¹⁴
- 3.1.8.2.2.3. activities of international (and private) banks, which is the least studied and the subject of the least professional work.

- 3.1.12. All contemporary and major migrations can be viewed through three basic contemporary global political mega-trends, ¹⁵ three basic tendencies, present at the beginning of the 21st century in international relations:
 - 3.1.12.1. The first mega-trend: Globalization/de-globalization¹⁶ (the accent is on the state or nation sovereignty, isolationism such as Brexit etc.),
 - 3.1.12.2. The second mega-trend: Integration/disintegration (i.e. the USSR)
 - 3.1.12.3. The third mega-trend: Democratization/autocratization.

Each specific migration can be part of globalization processes, where in the country of origin of migrants migration influences the strengthening of disintegration processes, and in the country that accepts them they can be a factor of political integration into the new environment. It is important to note that mass uncontrolled migration is increasingly producing political processes that counter globalization.

Let us remind ourselves briefly that all of these forms of mobility are affected by different causes and factors. Under certain circumstances, each of these forms of migration may be the subject of interest of the intelligence and security sector of a particular state or of a military-political alliance of states. The reason for considering this or that form is most often hidden in the intentions of the migrants (real and

covert) and their relation to the host country. What do we want to say? Even in the situation of migrants having a sincere intention to establish a new way of life in a new environment, the way in which they wish to realize it may cause concern. Consider, for example, economic migrants from the Republic of Turkey, who have lived in different countries of Western Europe for years, some of them for decades. It is a population whose migration took place in the 1960s and 1970s, whose children, and in some families and grandchildren, were born in the present-day European Union. In a referendum organized by Turkey on April 16, 2017, Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdogan and his AKP party (tur. Adalet ve Kalkınma Partisi) have obtained the highest percentage of approval votes for the Turkish state's transformation into a presidential dictatorship from Turkish emigrants in the Federal Republic of Germany and Belgium. Nearly two-thirds, and in some German provinces and cities, three-quarters of adult Turkish immigrants, voted to amend the Turkish Constitution and increase powers to President Erdogan. In other words, they voted for the greater influence of religion on politics and the attempt to revitalize the Ottoman Empire. That is, everyone who voted in favor spoke indirectly against the further development of a secular state and Western-style democracy in Turkey, but also against the political, civilizational and economic interests of the country in which they live, study, work, or from where they earn their pension. For days, the mass media have transmitted photographs of members of extremist organizations, such as the "Gray Wolves" ("Bozkurtçular" or "Idealists"), an ultra-rightist organization operating on a platform of panturkism, nationalism and neo-fascism, with the intended purpose of building a "Big Turan", or a state that should unite all Turkish-speaking peoples from the Republic of Hungary¹⁷ to the Xinjiang-Uyghur Autonomous Region (in the PRC), who number more than 20,000 in Germany alone. They celebrated the success of the Turkish referendum in the streets of major German cities.

CONCLUSION

Although this work is not a systematically organized entirety of knowledge on the problem of migration, nor did it have the ambition to be, it is hoped that, like any knowledge, it possesses a certain, at least the necessary minimum, awareness and is capable of further self-development as a whole. The authors have endeavored to gather from the accessible public knowledge additional truths into the knowledge necessary to survive in these difficult, in some of our colleagues, pre-finite, and in our understanding of events around us, in post-finite times. At the same time, without rejecting non-literal knowledge, meaning that which is not necessary for survival, the authors at one point in time gave their maximum to create a work that would combine the main factors into a stable scientific structure whose essence would contribute to the understanding of chaos produced by contemporary migration.

Anarcholiberal politicians and self-proclaimed and unconfirmed philanthropists can often hear their view that "humane and orderly migration contributes to both migrants and society." This view is seen as highly debatable and fundamentally inaccurate by the authors of this paper. Forcibly and intentionally triggered by inhuman activity, mass migration does indeed feature the enormous chaotic waves triggered by a disaster (war, economic distress, famine and misery). They are a kind of social tsunami made with the desire to make people waves for the Great Social Flood and to overthrow all obstacles in the exercise of boundless power by the anarcholiberal pseudo-elite. All forms of external migration, and even demographic decline in the country under review, speak unequivocally of the inability of a well-defined elite in society to plan and implement ideas of general development. In which direction the anarcho-liberal elite (sk. ALE) of the West is planning developments is perhaps indicated by the works of Dr. Heinzon, a lecturer at NATO College in Rome and the Federal Security Academy of Germany. This serious analyst argues that no one in the near future will be able to stop migrants from Asia and Africa, and that by 2030, a mass of potential people seeking primarily higher social living conditions, e.g. such as in Europe, will be around 700 to 800 million people. Acceptance of the political ideas behind the scenes, embodied in his migrant affairs by George Soros and a group of people around him, prove that the status of social law on their part will no longer be respected in the former metropolises, and in all colonies, old and new, close or distant the situation will be much worse. There is a growing circle of people in the West who realize this

and make the right decision that if one party (ALE) does not follow the rules of the game, then they no longer have to play by the rules rejected by those who consider themselves, completely unjustified, as the social elite. Therefore, all of us, as soon as tomorrow, will have to face the same dilemma that Aesop had to deal with at the end of his life. Will we voluntarily and publicly admit that we are someone's slaves, or will we adamantly and openly say that we are free people, stand up and confront everyone with his own cliff. 18 Before making the most important decision in our lives, it must be understood that the time of Darkness, Night, Chaos and Destruction, the time of the Apocalypse has definitely passed. Their negative program has come to an end and a new, completely different one has been released. Slightly, without great words and pomp, we have entered an era of Light, Day, and Order, which will inevitably bring about development, harmony, and Love without which there is no development. As time goes on, its amount will increase, thanks to the significantly higher frequencies at which Earth functions. At the height of the development of this new civilization, it will surely be 160 times more than it is now.¹⁹

In order for the flow, the direction of the movement of time, to move towards new social solutions, a new ideology, a new collective consciousness, a new energy-information platform, with new concepts in language and communication, is needed. This is why the terms financial terrorism and financial colonialism are irreplaceable ideological weapons in the impending ideological conflict with the

Western anarcho-liberal elite (ALE) and their globalist patrons. As soon as the consciousness of the magnitude and form of the problem into which, without our conscious consent, which was first crystallized in the East and then elsewhere on the planet, more collective and later a general mental basis for the construction and consolidation of a new ideology would be created. At that moment, the flow (direction) of time, once written by Nikolay Kozirev, will move even further to the East and any attempts by infernal structures to slow it down or reverse it will fail and will only accelerate the flow of time (and energy) towards the East. In essence, the new ideology will be liberating for the disenfranchised, in many ways robbed and forcibly marginalized and as recorded in the book of the prophet Daniel, "everything that is secret will become general (public) and the invisible world will become visible." and energy towards the East can no longer be stopped and aware of this, the enlightened part of the infernal structures will try to move physically and businessly to the East, but no matter what, they will be discovered very quickly and most will be destroyed primarily by the increase in Earth's frequencies, the solar system and our galaxy. It is estimated that the most important tendency in international relations from 2021 to 2025, and especially after 2040, will be the growing role of the national human factor (potential) and its institutes. This means that in the first half of this century, a redistribution of a whole range of groups of internal factors will be made, which will influence the international situation in favor of increasing the importance of those who are, in one way or another, connected with: the human capital of local human civilizations, the quality of the ruling elite and society and the means of influencing local human civilizations, society and nation.²⁰ The underlying tendency had previously fully reflected reality, and now it reflects the virtuality that, often by using different forms of force, certain major players in the international arena are (trying to) transform into reality.²¹ We can see that their virtuality has a direct correlation with the growing virulence of the middle and lower classes in the metropolises and all economic strata in the colonies. The only exceptions are members of the colonial pseudoelite.

There is no equality between the energy generated in hybrid (and asymmetric armed conflicts) wars and its expenditure. Why? For many reasons. First, because of the internal energy and financial imbalances present in all states led by anarcho-liberal elites (aka ALE), meaning between the outcast sections of the financial elite and the rest of society, which makes up 99% of the population. The stratification of societies, not just the West, is rapidly deepening. From retirement conditions, rising consumer basket prices, declining levels of health insurance and education, to general inequality before the law. These are also the strongest reasons why ALEs have problems mobilizing and motivating broader populations for new wars and looting abroad. Secondly, the energy generated in closed sets of TNK management types does not correspond to the frequencies present in the vast majority of society, which feels betrayed and deceived and increasingly turns to themselves and to solving their problems, which they see imposed on others. In addition to existential problems, they are increasingly provoked by the question: Does their current political system need to be defended at all, or should it passively or perhaps actively work on its disappearance? Some parts of the West's financial elites are aware of this fact, since for some time now they have been actively working to revitalize their most loyal guards, political parties of the far right, neo-Nazism and neo-fascism, whose representatives are increasingly represented on the political scene of Europe, Latin America and elsewhere. Thirdly, plunder from the countries where the so-called colored revolutions, hybrid wars, and asymmetrical armed conflicts, did not take a serious part in improving the living standards of metropolitan citizens. On the contrary, it continues to degrade in all areas of life. The lion's share of the spoils belonged to the outcast sections of the financial elites and TNK managers, who live in their own, isolated, wealthy world and are (for now) unaffected by the problems of ordinary people. Fourth, negative emotions (fear, anger, envy, hatred, aggression, etc.) operate at frequencies below 10 Hz and are increasingly suppressed by objective physical sources by higher frequencies. As time goes by, there will be less and less negative emotions, and more and more positive emotions, love, understanding, compassion, kindness, and such a situation will not be able to change even the planned 20,000 US satellites in low orbital paths, predicted by ALE to control human behavior through the 5G network.

At the end of this paper, are there any answers to the situation in which contemporary colonized states have found themselves, targets of potential migrant chaos? Of course there is. First and foremost, it is necessary to devise a new language to

describe the desired version of the future, regardless of the potential concentration of esoterics in it. We need to find the right combination of words and terms that can fully characterize the variant of the future in which we want to live. In the short, medium and longer term. Fully acceptable to most of the existing population. Second, starting from the adopted linguistic terms of our future, we must devise an ideological doctrine, a conceptual model of conquering desired ends, with all its characteristics. Bearing in mind that the pseudo-elite showed an absolute inability to solve any task in any colony, it is necessary to proceed on the basis of proclaimed conceptual solutions to form a new base of the political elite. Third, when the previous two are fully implemented, concrete moves on the international scene should be made.

МИГРАНТИ – КЛАСИФИКАЦИЈА И ПОТЕНЦИЈАЛНИ ОДГОВОРИ НА ИЗАЗОВЕ МИГРАНТСКИХ ТАЛАСА, КАО ДЕЛА ХИБРИДНИХ И АСИМЕТРИЧНИХ РАТОВА САДАШЊОСТИ

Апстракт

Победа транснационалних корпорација над СССР-ом и потписивање дефакто капитулације омогућили су, у међународним односима, стварање унополарног света. Ароганција хегемона уништила је оно што је остало од међународног права и створила је окружење у којем се сила може некажњено применити на било којег члана међународног клуба. У тим околностима се и раније у историји појављивале су се уцене, јачала је употреба оружане силе, несмотрено условљавање, хибридни ратови, ратови под заставама других људи или асиметрични (оружани и ненаоружани) сукоби у новој литератури. Незаобилазан део њих су вештачки изазване масовне миграције, пажљиво осмишљене и усмерене на најопасније политичке и економске конкуренције хегемона. Сакривајући се иза помно изречених и јавно лепо негованих еуфемизама о такозваним људским правима, владавини међународног права и транспарентности политичке активности, ствараоци мигрантског хаоса и даље вуку конце на међународној сцени, играјући се са десетинама милиона људских живота. Након одрицања од националног суверенитета, европске земље су у ситуацији да нису у стању да заштите своје границе, становништво и економију од мигрантског цунамија.
